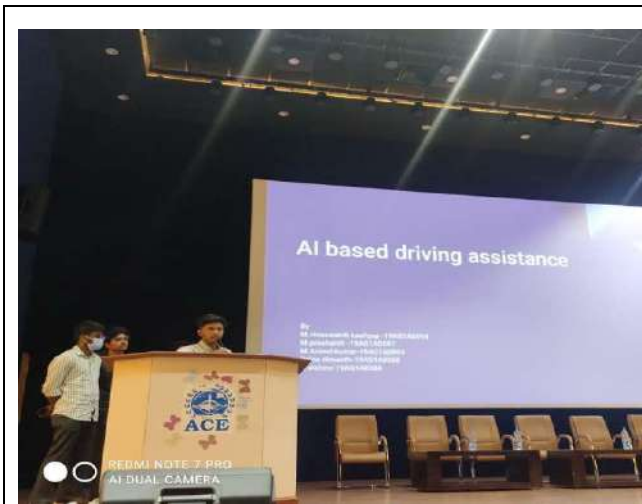

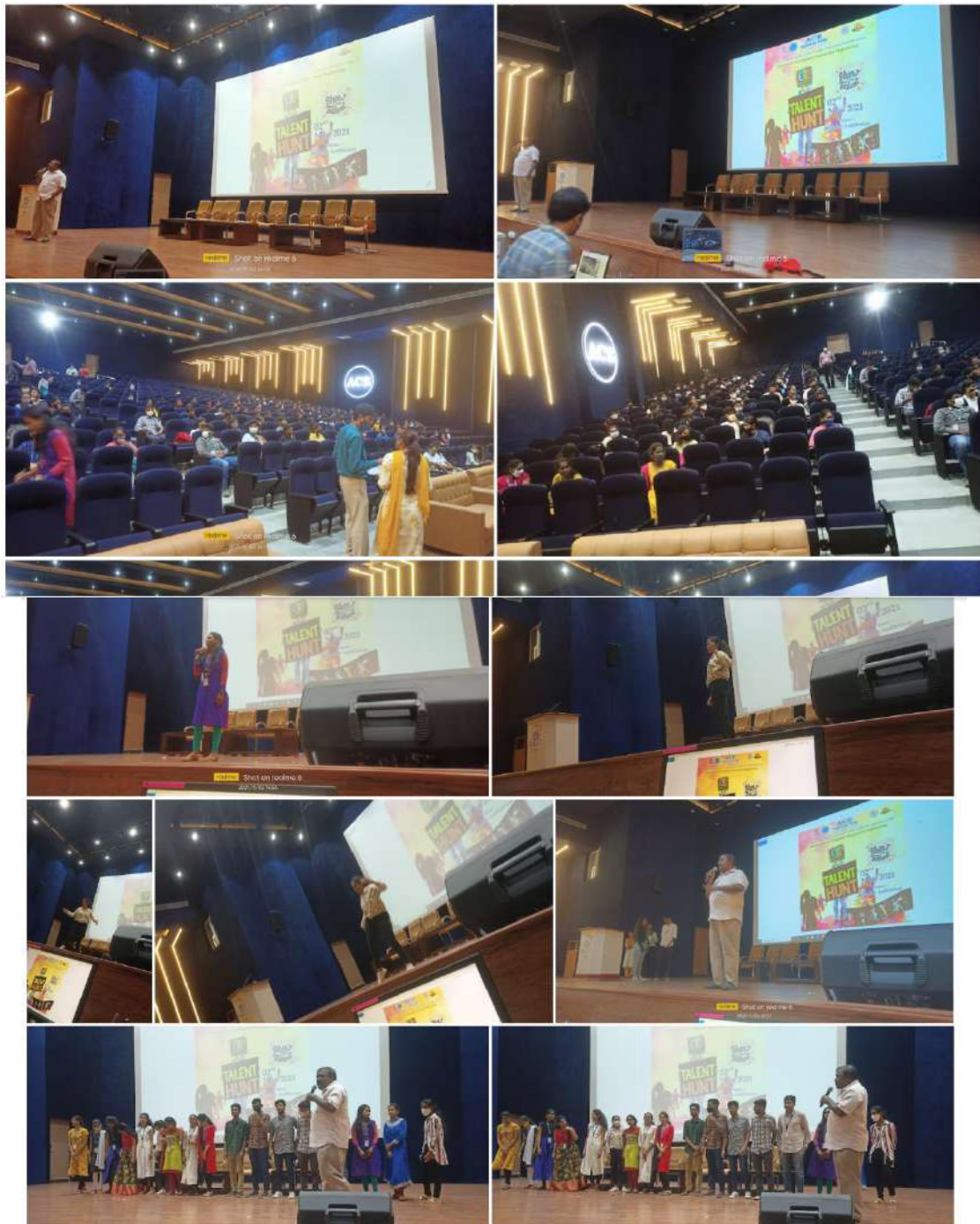

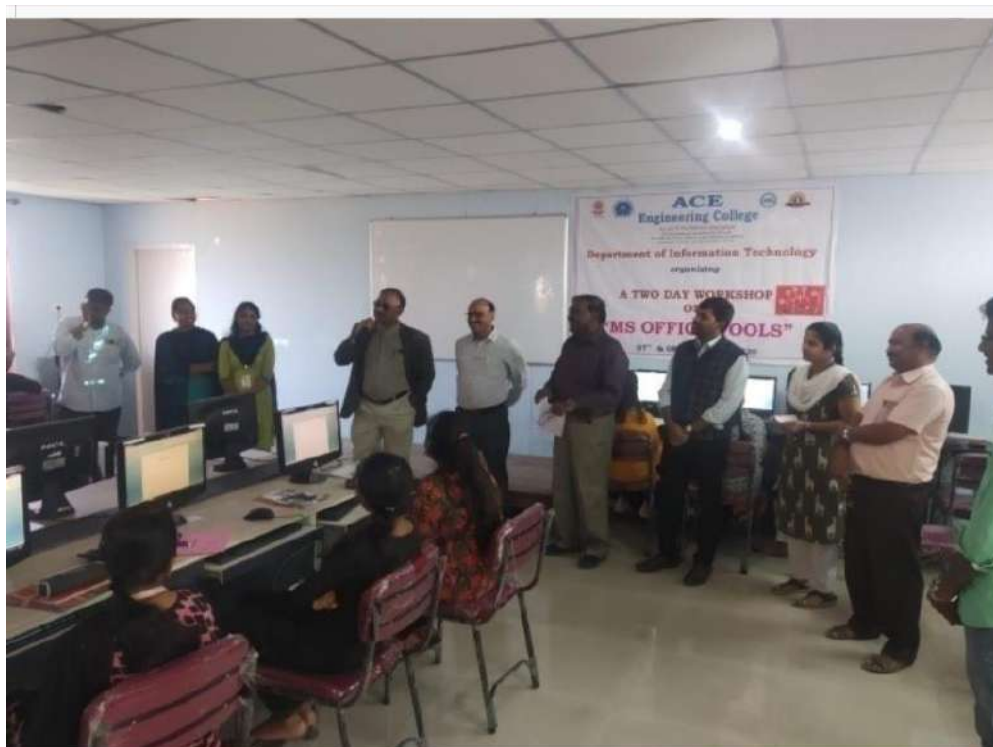

The Department of Computer Science and Engineering organized a coding contest of “**rACE it-2019 A National Level Coding Contests in C, JAVA, and PYTHON programming languages**” in association with Microsoft Innovation Center (MIC).
